Stockport Asset Tagging and Digitisation

The Customer:



Task: Stockport Homes required a thorough record of their gates, barriers and balustrades. ODC were tasked with physically tagging these and capturing them in GIS.

Data: ODC were provided with Stockport Homes stock list. This was used as a basis for property visits to identify assets.

Method: DC completed on-site asset tagging with the use of GISMO. This allowed ODC to physically tag the asset and at the same time. digitise the location with a unique ID corresponding to the tag. A picture of the asset in-situ was also taken and linked to the feature. A guick assessment of the asset's condition was also attributed to the feature (e.g. missing, needs repair etc). Post-capture work was undertaken to ensure each asset was linked to the property and was accurately located.





Result: Stockport Homes were provided with a dedicated map for their assets. This enables them to ensure contractors review all assets. Mobile collection has been set up for Stockport, enabling them to maintain and build on the collected data and will assist in any future tender exercise.
